

Trends & Commentary

- Spotify is planning to offer shares through a direct public offering (DPO), thereby eliminating the need for an investment bank as the underwriter. The Company will do so by holding a public auction on the NYSE or Nasdag, which while unusual, has been done before, most notably, in the case of Ben & Jerry's DPO in 1984. The DPO could save approximately 7%, or \$300 million, in underwriting fees.
- Blackstone has purchased a majority stake in Titus, a provider of data protection software, for \$100 million. This marks 16% of Blackstone's deals in the IT sector, the highest since 2009.
- Apax Partners has closed its Apax Digital fund at \$1.0 billion, exceeding its \$800 million target. The fund will target companies in the enterprise tech, consumer and internet sectors, with both minority and majority investments between \$30 million and \$150 million.
- Edgewater Funds has closed its fourth flagship fund at over \$1.0 billion. The growth fund will primarily make minority investments in the middle market, typically in health care, information technology, software and consumer products sectors.
- Greenspring Associates is planning on raising \$100 million for its second micro fund, which will manage investments for pension plans, insurance companies, endowments and family offices.
- ConvergeOne has agreed to merge with Forum Merger, a special purpose acquisition company, which will raise \$1.2 billion in ConvergeOne's public offering. ConvergeOne is a provider of IT and collaboration services, and is backed by Clearlake Capital.
- Bridgepoint has exceeded its €5.5 billion target for its latest fund. The Company invests in business services, consumer products and services, financial services, media and technology sectors.

- Fetch Robotics, a developer of autonomous mobile robots, raised \$25 million in Series B funding at a \$125 million pre-money valuation Sway Ventures led the round.
