
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Private Placement Activity

3/19/2018 – 3/23/2018 (Transactions in excess of \$20 million)

Trends & Commentary

- This week, 15 U.S. private placement deals between \$20 million and \$50 million closed, accounting for \$452 million in total proceeds, compared to last week's 13 U.S. deals leading to \$421 million in total proceeds. This week also had 6 U.S. deals between \$50 million and \$100 million yielding \$365 million, compared to last week's 5 deals resulting in \$341 million in total proceeds.
- U.S. corporate venture capital deal volume has grown over the past decade from \$10.0 billion in 2008 to \$37.4 billion in 2017. The number of deals has increased as well, from 674 in 2008 to 1,268 in 2017. (see figure)
- Dropbox priced its IPO at \$21 per share and traded up 40% on its opening to close at \$28.48 a share. The
 Company raised \$756 million and had an initial market cap of more than \$8.0 billion. Dropbox previously
 raised \$350 million in Series C funding at a \$9.7 billion pre-money valuation from BlackRock in 2014.
- Zscaler, a provider of a global cloud security platform, priced its IPO last week at \$27.50 per share, raising \$192 million. The Company had originally planned to sell 10 million shares between \$10 and \$12 a share.
- Village Global, a fund backed by Bill Gates and Jeff Bezos, has raised \$100 million for its first flagship seed fund. Portfolio companies will receive mentorship from the firm's backers.
- Zuora, an operator of a SaaS enterprise platform that automates subscriptions, filed to go public last week.
 The Company is expecting to raise \$100 million. Zuora recorded \$168 million in revenue and a net loss of \$47 million in 2017.
- Madrona Venture Group has hired Sudip Chakrabartias as Partner, who will focus on the cloud computing and digital media sectors. Sudip was previously was a Partner at Lightspeed Ventures.
- Lightspeed Ventures hired Semil Shah as a Venture Partner. Semil will continue to run Haystack, a seed-stage fund that had previously invested in DoorDash and Instacart.
- Tripp Smith, the Co-Founder of GSO Capital Partners, is retiring and will leave the firm in June.
