Trends & Commentary



- 2017 saw higher U.S. VC deal values across fewer deals, reaching \$24 billion in Q4 2017 across 1,778 deals. While VC deals dropped across angel / seed, early and later VC, deal value rose 12% in the fourth quarter. (see figure)
- Sofi, an operator of a low fixed-rate loan company, acquired Clara Lending to expand their offerings beyond student-loan refinancing. The Company has also closed a \$960 million offering of loan notes, the Company's largest securitization to date.
- Dell is reportedly seeking to IPO through a reverse merger with VMware, of which Dell already owns a controlling stake. The move would allow Dell to use VMware's cash to pay off some of its debt.
- BMW has agreed to acquire a stake in DriveNow, a car-sharing platform in Europe, for \$259 million, putting DriveNow at a \$521 million valuation. The acquisition was reportedly to merge with BMW's Daimler, a manufacturer and distributor of automotive engineering parts.
- Amazon, Berkshire Hathaway and JPMorgan Chase have announced their plans for an independent healthcare company that will improve care and reduce costs for U.S. employees. The Company will be free from profit-making constraints and will focus on developing tech-based solutions to solve inefficiencies in the healthcare industry.
- Blackstone has agreed to acquired 55% of Thomson Reuters' financial and risk business for \$17.0 billion, Blackstone's largest deal since the financial crisis.
- SAP has agreed to acquire CallidusCloud, a sales software business for \$2.4 billion a 21% premium to the Company's 30-day volume weighted average.
- General Catalyst has hired Ken Chenault, the former CEO of American Express, as Chairman and Managing Director.
