- Real estate companies have demonstrated a recent trend towards investing in retail technology and e-Commerce companies, or companies that service these groups Simon Property Group
 has made 24 unique investments, including SmarterHQ and Deliv.
- Investments in traditional brick-and-mortar stores are declining, partly due to Amazon's recent success. PE investors have completed 75 investments in this space this year, a major decrease from 2016's 185 transactions and 2015's 183 transactions.
- The bid for Toshiba's memory chip business has concluded. Several investors, including Bain Capital and South Korean chipmaker SK Hynix, will purchase the memory chip business for \$18 billion.
- Prosper, a developer of a marketplace lending platform, had a recent down round. In its Series G funding, the Company raised \$50 million at a \$500 million pre-money valuation, compared to a \$1.9 billion valuation in 2015. Similarly, its closest competitor, Lending Club, experienced a 68% decline in valuation since 2015.
