#### **Trends & Commentary**

- U.S. middle-market PE deal values through Q3 have reached \$233.0B in deal value across 1.7K deals, an increase of 13.0% in deal value and a decrease in 1.5% in deals since last year. With higher deal values and fewer deals, the median mid-market EBITDA multiples have grown to reach 10.7x through 2017 Q3, the highest level on record. (see figure)
- Adams Street Partners, an investment firm that invests in business services, consumer product, information technology and other sectors, has just hired James Walker as Partner and COO. Prior to joining Adams Street Partners, James was COO at Credit Suisse Private Bank Americas.
- Geoff Lewis, a former Founders Fund partner, has formed Bedrock Capital with Eric Stromberg, a co-founder of book app Oyster. The newly-formed VC will invest in Series A and B rounds, and has raised \$118M for its debut fund.
- Onex, a Canadian private equity firm, surpassed its \$6.5B target and raised \$7.2B for its fifth flagship buyout fund. The Company invests in B2B and financial services, and has raised the five largest PE funds to be raised by a Canadian private equity firm.
- Stitch Fix's recent IPO has fallen short of expectations, with an offering of \$15 per share, below the anticipated range of \$18-\$20 per share, reaching a \$1.5B valuation. The Company raised \$120M from its IPO, which values Stitch Fix well above its \$300M valuation in 2014, but below its anticipated \$2.0B valuation. Stich Fix raised \$25M in Series C funding in 2014 from Benchmark, Lightspeed Venture Partners, Baseline Ventures and Western Technology Investment.
