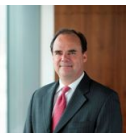

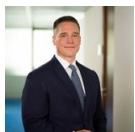

Background

- Headquartered in Munich, Germany, Tecvia is one of the leading pan-European providers of digital content and software solutions for driving license training and the education of commercial drivers
- Through its integrated platform, Tecvia digitizes and supports the entire value chain of driving schools and institutions. Tecvia offers end-to-end solutions from fully featured ERP systems with third-party interfaces to advanced teaching software for all license classes and digital learning media
- Harris Computer is a mission-critical software and service solutions provider for the public sector, healthcare, utilities, private sector, and insurance markets globally, and is a fully-owned subsidiary of Constellation Software (TSX: CSU), a leading provider of software and services
- Unigestion is an independent specialist asset management company providing innovative, tailored solutions for investors worldwide

Process

- DC Advisory was mandated as exclusive financial advisor to Unigestion on the sale of its portfolio company, Tecvia
- DC Advisory supported Tecvia during the sell-side process by coordinating all due diligence workstreams and providing comprehensive strategic advice on all aspects of the transaction
- DC Advisory utilized its trusted relationship with Tecvia to find a partner with deep expertise who could enable Tecvia to grow further and strengthen its position in

the driving Technology and Software sector

Outcome

- In October 2025, Unigestion entered into a definitive agreement to sell its shareholding in Tecvia to Harris Computer for an undisclosed amount
- The closing of the transaction is expected to take place in November 2025, and is subject to customary closing conditions and regulatory approvals
- The acquisition of Tecvia complements Harris Computer's strategy. As a strategic acquirer, Harris Computer is committed to Tecvia's long-term development and will further grow the business. Tecvia and its locations and strategy will remain unchanged
- This is the second transaction in which DC Advisory has advised on the sale of Tecvia (formerly Springer Nature PTU), reflecting our clients' continued confidence in our team, our execution capability, and our track record of driving long-term strategic value across multiple ownership cycles
